The Kawasaki Water Business Network (KaWaBiz NET) held the Kawasaki Water Business Network FY2017 General Assembly on July 21, 2017 at the Kawasaki Chamber of Commerce and Industry Conference Hall. The event was attended by 70people, including Chairman Koizumi (Professor Emeritus, Graduate School of Urban Environmental Sciences Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering, Tokyo Metropolitan University), Special Advisor Fukuda (Mayor of Kawasaki City), and Special Advisor Yamada (Chairman of the Kawasaki Chamber of Commerce and Industry) as well as other 37 members and 8 supporting organizations.
