

JICA Partnership Program Wrap-Up Seminar in Makassar

The Waterworks and Sewerage Bureau of the City of Kawasaki is currently conducting a project in the Indonesian cities of Makassar (waterworks) and Bandung (sewerage) that leverages the JICA Partnership Program's regional revitalization bracket.

On August 7, 2025, a wrap-up seminar was held in Makassar to present the project's results. The seminar was attended by the Mayor of Makassar, the Acting President of Regional Water Company of Makassar City, the Acting Head of the South Sulawesi Provincial Office, the Head of the Consular Office in Makassar, the Deputy Director of JICA Indonesia, and Professor Akira Koizumi, Specially Appointed Professor at Tokyo Metropolitan University and Chairman of KaWaBiz NET.
